- Class 1 Junior Novice Eventer Trial 85cm Max**
Horse/pony not to have won any BE/EI Points. All horses may be currently registered with BE/EI and these must not have any BE/EI points, nor must they have been placed in the first six places in any BE/EI Pre-Novice competition. Riders must be 18yrs or under on 1 January 2010. Combination of horse/pony and rider may not enter class 5.
- Class 2 Junior Pairs Eventer Trial 85cm Max**
Horses/ponies not to have won more than 20 BE/EI points.
Show Jumping will be performed as a baton relay followed by both competitors riding the cross country as a pair. There will be a dressing fence. Riders must be 18yrs or under on 1 January 2010.
- Class 3 Senior Novice Eventer Trial 85cm Max**
Horse/pony not to have won any BE/EI Points. All horses may be currently registered with BE/EI and these must not have any BE/EI points, nor must they have been placed in the first six places in any BE/EI Pre-Novice competition. Riders must be over 18yrs on 1 January 2010. Combination of horse/pony and rider may not enter class 6.
- Class 4 Senior Pairs Eventer Trial 85cm Max**
Horses/ponies not to have won more than 20 BE/EI points.
Show Jumping will be performed as a baton relay followed by both competitors riding the cross country as a pair. There will be a dressing fence. Riders must be over 18yrs on 1 January 2010.
- Class 5 Junior Open Eventer Trial 100cm Max**
Horses/ponies not to have won more than 20 BE/EI points. Riders must be 18yrs or under on 1 January 2010. Combination of horse/pony and rider may not enter class 1.
- Class 6 Senior Open Eventer Trial 100cm Max**
Horses/ponies not to have won more than 20 BE/EI points. Riders must be over 18yrs on 1 January 2010. Combination of horse/pony and rider may not enter class 2.

ENTRY FEES: SWDRC member £12, non SWDRC member £15.

ENTRIES: Close on 13 March 2010. **NO ENTRIES WILL BE TAKEN ON THE DAY. Early entry advised as numbers ARE limited. Entries accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.** Cheques made payable to: Saffron Walden & District RC. By placing an entry you automatically agree to abide by the rules of the competition and the Club. **NOTE: SWDRC reserves the right to close classes prior to entry close date should they become full. In this event entries will be returned.**

TIMES: All competitors will be allocated a start time prior to the competition. These will be emailed out and can be found on www.swdrc.co.uk (if you do not have email or internet please phone 01799 527182 on the Wednesday prior to the event).

COMPETITION FORMAT: A show jumping phase from which each competitor will follow straight on to the cross country course.

WALKING THE COURSE: Course open for walking on Saturday 20 March from 2.30pm **ONLY** and on day of the event. **Walking of the course is at your own risk and attention should be paid to stand well clear of any competitors on the course, any spectators and course walkers must abide by any instruction issued by event judges and officials.**

PRIZES: Rosettes to 6th place in all classes. Members rosette to highest placed SWDRC member in each class. A **cross-country points system** will operate throughout the year with a points trophy being awarded at the AGM to the junior and senior SWDRC member and horse/pony combination with the most points at the end of the season.

VENUE DIRECTIONS: Shire Hill Farm is located on the B1053 to the east of Saffron Walden by Tesco. Sat Nav. CB10 2JZ.

RULES: Please see full rules before making an entry as receipt of entry means that the entrant agrees to abide by the rules of the Saffron Walden and District Riding Club.

- At all Saffron Walden & District Riding Club (SWDRC) events all competitors must wear a crash hat when mounted with chin straps fastened to comply with BSEN 4472/6473 or BSEN 1384 or PAS 015 (which are recommended by the British Riding Clubs). **FAILURE TO COMPLY INCURS IMMEDIATE ELIMINATION.**
- In case of bad weather conditions please either call the secretary or tel: 07919 312041 for an event update.
- All competitors must wear an approved body protector (level 7 red label is not recommended under the BETA standard).
- No receiving, recording, transmitting or monitoring device may be used by a competitor during any phase of any competition failure to comply with this rule will incur elimination.
- Provisional results will be posted as soon after the end of each class as is possible and final results 10 minutes thereafter. Any objections to the provisional results should be made within this 10 minutes together with a £10 deposit, which will be refunded only if the objection is upheld.
- Horses and ponies may only compete in ONE class (excluding Pairs) and only once in any one class.
