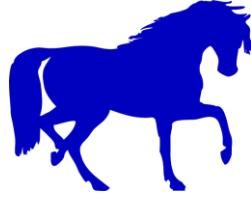

Clear Round – 09:15am – 10:00am 45cm (18")

£5 per round (pay on collecting ring gate)

Show Jumping Classes – Commencing at 10:00am prompt.

All Classes will be run single phase.

Class 1a*	45cm	(18")	Novice (Can be assisted)
Class 1b	45cm	(18")	Open
Class 2a*	60cm	(2ft)	Novice
Class 2b	60cm	(2ft)	Open

*Classes 1a and 2a are for Novices only and combination must not have won 2 firsts in any class.

*No affiliated horses / ponies

Class 3 70cm (2ft 3")

The Oliver Trophy to highest placed junior member riding a pony 148 cm (14.2hh) and under

Please wear an armband/scrunchie to show that you are eligible for the Oliver Trophy

Class 4 75cm (2ft 6")

The Bentley Country Park Shield to highest placed senior member

The Simon Trophy to highest placed junior member riding a pony 148 cm (14.2h) and under

Please wear an armband/scrunchie to show that you are eligible for the Simon Trophy

Class 5 85cm (2ft 9")

The NEW Sebastian Senior Trophy – Senior member, riding a horse over 148 cm (14.2hh)

The Lowry Cup – Junior member on pony 148 cm (14.2h) and under

Please wear an armband/scrunchie to show that you are eligible for the Lowry Trophy

Class 6 90cm (3ft)

The Chisnell Trophy to highest placed senior member.

The Hill House Farm shield to highest placed Young Rider member 21 years and under, riding a horse over 128cm.

Please wear an armband/scrunchie to show that you are eligible for the Hill House Farm Shield

Class 7 1m (3ft 3")

The Greyhound Caravan Open Trophy to highest placed member

Class 8 1.10m (3ft 6") Horses only

The Tendring Hundred Riding Club Rose Bowl to highest placed member

Class 9 1.15m (3ft 9") Horses only

The Thorpe Market Trophy to highest placed member

Show Jumping Rules – Please Read

- All heights are approximate in the first round and judged under Affiliated Riding Club rules – The Judge's decision is final.
- No horse/pony to jump in more than **three** classes (excluding Clear Round)

Ring 2 – Working Hunter Ring (Morning)

Classes – Commencing at 09:30am prompt.

No horse/pony to jump in more than **two** classes (excluding Clear Round)

Classes may be split Horse/Pony and/or Junior/Senior. Working Hunter Pony is 15hh and under.

- Class 10** **Very Novice Working Hunter / Pony** (Rider any age)
Lead Rein allowed
Fences approx. 45cm (18")
- Class 11** **Mountain and Moorland Working Hunter Pony - Small Breeds** (Rider any age)
Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh A & B – to be shown in natural state.
Open to Registered and Unregistered Ponies
Lead Rein allowed
Fences approx. 60cm (2ft)
- Class 12** **Novice Working Hunter / Pony** (Rider any age)
Fences approx. 60cm (2ft)
Combination of pony and rider not to have won an Open Working Hunter Pony
The J F Aldous Shield to highest placed member riding a pony 15hh and under.
- Class 13** **Mountain and Moorland Working Hunter Pony - Large Breeds** (Rider any age)
Connemara, New Forest, Highland, Dales, Fell, Welsh C & D – to be shown in natural state. Open to Registered and Unregistered Ponies
Fences approx. 70cm (2ft 3")
- Class 14** **Working Hunter / Pony** (Rider any age)
Fences approx. 70cm (2ft 3")
The Chiswood Cup to highest placed member riding a pony 15hh and under.
- Class 15** **Working Hunter / Pony** (Rider any age)
Fences approx. 75cm (2ft 6")
The Oliver Cup to highest placed member riding a pony 15hh and under.
- Class 16** **Working Hunter / Pony** (Rider any age)
Fences approx. 85cm (2ft 9")
The Isaac Cup to highest placed member riding a pony 15hh and under.
- Class 17** **Working Hunter/ Pony** (Rider any age)
Fences approx. 90 cm to 1.00m (3ft to 3ft 3")
Greyhound Caravan Perpetual Trophy to Winner
Lesley Doe Salver to highest placed member exceeding 15hh
Woodhill Lad Perpetual Trophy to the best hunter in class 17 who has hunted at least three times with the Essex and Suffolk Hunt or East Essex Hunt 2019 / 2020 season (please tell steward as you enter ring if you are eligible for this trophy).

Ring 2 – Working Hunter Ring (Afternoon)

Not to start before 1:00pm

- Class 18 Riding Club Horse**
Exceeding 14.2hh
Will be required to jump two or three fences
Approx. 75cm to 85cm (2ft 6" to 2ft 9")
To be judged on suitability for all Riding Club activities
The Chaeron Ford Memorial Trophy to highest placed member
- Class 19 Riding Club Pony**
14.2hh and under
Will be required to jump two or three fences
Approx. 70cm to 75cm (2ft 3" to 2ft 6")
To be judged on suitability for all Riding / Pony Club activities.
- Class 20 Family Pony**
14.2hh and under
Meridian Business Machines cup to Highest Placed Member
- Class 21 Family Horse**
Over 14.2hh
Premier Tyres Trophy to Highest Placed Member
- Class 22 Ridden Veteran Pony**
15 years and over
*The 'Bronwyn Trophy' to the highest placed member on a pony 14.2hh and under.
Special rosette to Best Veteran over 20 years old.*
- Class 23 Ridden Veteran Horse**
15 years and over
*The 'Soulbury Golden Greeting Trophy' to the highest placed member on a horse
Special rosette to Best Veteran over 20 years old.*

Working Hunter Classes shall be judged as follows:

- Each competitor jumps a course of rustic fences
- All clear rounds (or possibly those with a few penalties, depending on class) will be called back into the ring to perform an individual show as advised by the judge
- Competitors will then be placed according to the judge's marks (jumping style, individual show and conformation of horse/pony – bearing in mind its suitability as a 'hunter' type).

Tack and turnout for Working Hunter:

- Rider – Tweed jacket (ideally), shirt, tie, and light coloured breeches / jodhpurs. Brown or tan gloves, long boots (adults), short boots (children), approved standard riding hat / jockey skull. No spurs for children or Mountain and Moorland riders
- Horse/Pony – any suitable bridle (martingales are allowed). Discreet numnah. Boots may be worn for the jumping phase only. Turn out according to type e.g. Mountain and Moorland ponies and cobs need not be plaited.

Tendring Hundred Riding Club Show Rules – Please Read Them

- Tendring Hundred Riding Club has taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid & prevent accidents occurring & must obey the instructions of the organisers /stewards whether written or verbal.
- Tendring Hundred Riding Club shall not be liable for any claim in respect of damage, loss, injury or accident to any person, horse or property howsoever caused. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that each entrant has read and understood these terms and conditions and shall indemnify T.H.R.C or any person acting on their behalf against any legal action arising from such an incident.
- To be eligible for points towards trophies you must be a member by April 30th. For further information on trophies please visit www.tendringhundredrc.co.uk
- All ridden horses/ponies must be four years old or over.
- Riders/handlers to be correctly turned out i.e., jacket, shirt, light-coloured breeches / jodhpurs, boots, tidy hair either in a hairnet or tied above collar. Junior handlers **must** wear a hard hat of the correct standard (see below).
- Hats: Must be worn to at least the following standard with a harness properly adjusted and fastened – skull caps must be worn with a silk. Riders must wear hats PAS 015 (998 or 2011), VG1 001.040 (2014-12), ASTM 1163 (2004a or 04a onwards), SNELL E2001 or E2016, AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards.) All with BSI kitemark or Inspec IC Mark. Any other standards/dates are **NOT** acceptable.
- Please park sensibly and do not block any entrances.
- Please pick up all droppings.
- Please remove all rubbish/litter or place in the bins provided.
- Please keep all dogs on leads and clean up all droppings.
- All children under the age of 16 years must always be supervised by a responsible adult.
- Judged under Affiliated Riding Club Rules. **The Judges' decision is final.**
- Only competing horses/ponies may be ridden on the showground on show days.
- All entries are payable at time of booking.
- Please read the schedule carefully!
- Thank you for following the rules and we hope you have an enjoyable day!
