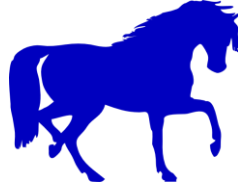

RING 1: Morning Classes (9am Start)

Class 1: In- Hand Senior Handler (Handler 15 years and over)

Class 2: In- Hand Young Handler (10 years and under) (Rosettes to all competitors)

Class 3: In- Hand Young Handler (11-14 years) (Rosettes to all competitors)

Class 4: In-Hand Mountain & Moorland Small Breeds

(Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh A & B, 4 years old and over, registered or unregistered)

Class 5: In-Hand Mountain & Moorland Large Breeds

(Connemara, New Forest, Highland, Dales, Fells, Welsh C & D, 4 years old and over, registered or unregistered)

Class 6: In-Hand Veteran

(Horse/Pony, any type/breed- 15 Years and over. Special rosettes for best horse/pony 20- 23 years & 24 years and over)

Class 7: In-Hand Coloureds

(Horse/Pony, any type/breed, piebald, skewbald, spots, duns, palominos & roans)

Class 8: In-Hand Blacks, Bays, Chestnuts & Greys (Horse/Pony, any type/breed)

*****Championship A ~ 1st & 2nd place winners from Classes 1-3 Handlers *****

*****Championship A ~ 1st & 2nd place winners from Classes 4-8 *****

Afternoon Classes (not to start before 1.00pm)

Class 9: Lead Rein Pony

(Any breed/type 12.2HH and under – rider 10 years and under, snaffle bits only, lead rein must be attached to noseband. Rosettes to all entries)

Class 10: First Ridden Pony

(Any breed/type 12.2HH and under – rider 12 years and under. Walk, trot and canter in individual show. Rosettes to all entries)

Class 11 Ridden Mountain & Moorland Large Breeds

(Connemara, New Forest, Highland, Dales, Fells, Welsh C & D), registered or unregistered)

Class 12: Ridden Mountain & Moorland Small Breeds

(Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh A & B, registered or unregistered)

Class 13: Ridden Veteran

(Horse/Pony, any type/breed- 15 Years and over. Special rosettes for best horse/pony 20- 23 years & 24 years and over)

Class 14: Ridden Coloureds

(Horse/Pony, any type/breed, piebald, skewbald, spots, duns, palominos & roans. Best colour rosettes).

Class 15: Ridden Blacks, Bays, Chestnuts & Greys (Horse/Pony, any type/breed. Best colour rosettes)

*****Championship B ~ 1st & 2nd place winners from Classes 9-15 *****

RING 2: Fun Classes (11am start)

If you don't have 'all the gear' for these classes, that's fine! As long as you are smart and safe with suitable footwear and a correct standard hat, that's great!

Please enter in the spirit intended and, most of all, have fun! 😊

Class 16: Fancy Dress

(To be shown mounted or in-hand. The children's involvement in creating the costume will be taken into consideration by the Judge. Riding hats and correct footwear must be worn by all competitors. Rider 14 years and under).

Class 17: Dog Fancy Dress

Class 18: Mini Fun Leading Rein

(12.2hh and under, rider 10 years and under. Walking only. Rosettes to all).

Class 19: Fun First Ridden Pony

(13.2hh and under, rider 11 years and under. No cantering. Assistance allowed but no lead reins).

Class 20: Dog and Dobbin

(Best matched dog and horse/pony)

Class 21: Best 6 Legs

Horse or Pony to be shown In-hand (Handler's Legs, Horse or Pony's Legs to match as best as can be).

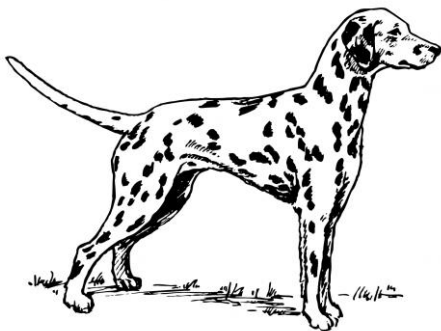
Class 22: Dog the judge would like to take home

Class 23: Pony the judge would like to take home

(Rider/handlers 14 years and under)

Class 24: Family Pony

(Rider any age. Will be required to jump a small jump and negotiate an obstacle. To be judged on suitability to be ridden by both adult and child family members. Snaffle bits only).

Tendring Hundred Riding Club Show Rules – Please Read Them

- Tendring Hundred Riding Club has taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid & prevent accidents occurring & must obey the instructions of the organisers /stewards whether written or verbal.
- Tendring Hundred Riding Club shall not be liable for any claim in respect of damage, loss, injury or accident to any person, horse or property howsoever caused. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that each entrant has read and understood these terms and conditions and shall indemnify T.H.R.C or any person acting on their behalf against any legal action arising from such an incident.
- To be eligible for points towards trophies you must be a member by April 30th. For further information on trophies please visit www.tendringhundredrc.co.uk
- All ridden horses/ponies must be four years old or over.
- Riders/handlers to be correctly turned out i.e., jacket, shirt, light-coloured breeches / jodhpurs, boots, tidy hair either in a hairnet or tied above collar. Junior handlers **must** wear a hard hat of the correct standard (see below).
- Hats: Must be worn to at least the following standard with a harness properly adjusted and fastened – skull caps must be worn with a silk. Riders must wear hats PAS 015 (998 or 2011), VG1 001.040 (2014-12), ASTM 1163 (2004a or 04a onwards), SNELL E2001 or E2016, AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards.) All with BSI kitemark or Inspec IC Mark. Any other standards/dates are **NOT** acceptable.
- All stallions/colts must be kept under control at all times and not handled or ridden by anyone under 14 years of age. **All stallions must wear a stallion disc on the bridle.**
- Please park sensibly and do not block any entrances.
- Please pick up all droppings.
- Please remove all rubbish/litter or place in the bins provided.
- Please keep all dogs on leads and clean up all droppings.
- All children under the age of 16 years must always be supervised by a responsible adult.
- Judged under Affiliated Riding Club Rules. **The Judges' decision is final.**
- Only competing horses/ponies may be ridden on the showground on show days.
- Please read the schedule carefully.
- Thank you for following the rules and we hope you have an enjoyable day!

***COVID-19 Compliance: PLEASE KEEP TO CURRENT SOCIAL DISTANCING GUIDELINES WHEN ON SHOWGROUND**

***these are subject to change according to current restrictions.**

Anyone that does not comply with event protocols will be disqualified and asked to leave the site immediately. There will be no exceptions to this rule.

Anyone displaying COVID-19 symptoms, however mild, should stay at home. Anyone who has been in contact with someone that is showing symptoms should stay at home. Anyone considered vulnerable should stay at home.

In line with BRC compliance and government advice, THRC must limit the numbers on site and follow certain protocols as follows:

- Spectators permitted but must adhere to social distancing and social gathering limits. Please keep this to a minimum.
- There will be hand sanitiser available, but we would encourage you to bring your own.
- Toilets available, but please adhere to social distancing.
- Competitor names will be checked on arrival.
- Please adhere to current Government guidelines in respect of social distancing rules.

Parking:

Our Club field is big enough to accommodate everyone with plenty of room for social distancing. Lorries/trailers should be the parked at least 5m apart, preferably more.

Please try to avoid bringing extra cars – if it is necessary, please park in the designated area.

Competing

Please follow instructions from the stewards/signage with regard to designated warm-up rings and class rings.

Please follow current social distancing guidelines.

Competitor Numbers

You will be allocated a 'bridle number' on My Riding Life. Please use this number to make your own competitor number for this show. Please provide your own string. (There will be spare numbers at the show). Many thanks.
